**Resolution 2023-3-** Councilperson D. Breidinger made a motion adopt Resolution 2023-3 which states: A resolution of council of the Borough of Glendon, Northampton County, Pennsylvania, appropriating the specific sums estimated to be required for the purposes of municipal government in fiscal year 2024 as evidenced by its approved budget, and levying a tax upon all real property in the Borough of Glendon subject to taxation for the fiscal year 2024 at the rate of eleven and sixty-four one-hundredths (11.64) mills on each dollar of assessed valuation, being \$1.164 per \$100.00 of assessed valuation. Vice-President K. Harstine seconded and the motion was unanimously approved.
