25 p.m. with the Pledge of Allegiance and roll call.

7 **Consideration of wage claim of Robert Patrey (con't):**

8 Vice-President M. Veres made a motion to pay an additional eight hours of wages to Robert  
9 Patrey. Councilperson A. Weisenberger-Caswell seconded. President D. Breidinger,  
10 Vice-President M. Veres and Councilperson A. Weisenberger-Caswell voted in favor.  
11 Councilpersons D. Young and K. Harstine voted against. The motion passed.

13 Councilperson D. Young questioned whether the fuel tank had been replaced on the  
14 backhoe since there is a rented Kubota in the parking lot. President D. Breidinger stated  
15 that because Jimmy Stevely had been busy, he is renting his Kubota to the borough free of  
16 charge. He was unable to get the fuel tank back on and advised that relining it is not  
17 possible due to the bad condition that the tank is in. The person who was going to reline it  
18 refused to do so because there is a high risk of leaking diesel fuel. President D. Breidinger  
19 said that the same estimated amount that was approved at the previous meeting to have the  
20 tank refabricated. She further stated that Mr. Stevely is going to take out the tank to have  
21 it looked at and rebuilt.
