16 additional month.

18 The Hugh Moore Park bridge (from Lehigh Drive) is scheduled to be closed for construction in
19 June of 2026. The canal boat will not be running, and the mules will return to their winter home.
20 Access to the park will be by bicycle/footpath from downtown Easton only.
