**Minutes:**

President Donna Breidinger asked for a motion to approve the minutes of January 5, 2026. Councilmember Kathryn Harstine made the motion, Councilmember Amy Weisenberger-Caswell seconded, all Ayes.

**Treasurer’s Report:**

**Bills to be paid:**

President Breidinger asked for a motion to pay the bills, with the exception of the paycheck for Jeffrey Breidinger. Mrs. Harstine made a motion to pay all bills. Ms. Caswell seconded, all Ayes.

President Breidinger asked for a motion to approve the paycheck for Mr. Breidinger. Vice-President Mike Veres made the motion, seconded by Ms. Caswell. Mr. Veres, Mrs. Harstine, Ms. Caswell and Councilmember Kurt Ostrander, Aye. President Breidinger abstained.

**Tax Collector’s Report:**

President Breidinger asked for a motion to accept the Tax Collector’s Report as presented. Mrs. Harstine made the motion, seconded by Ms. Caswell, all Ayes.

**Committee Reports:**

- Building: Nothing at this time.

**Committee Reports - continued:**

- Roads:
  - Two (2) potholes on Main Street have been filled.
  - A Streetlight survey is necessary, as there are many that are not working. Ms. Caswell will conduct the survey. Mr. Veres also asked for the list of locations of the streetlights.
- Signs:
  - Sign inventory and maintenance will be done in the spring.
  - Reliable Sign and Striping has traffic cones on sale at a cost of \$20.00 per cone. Council agreed to purchase six (6) as some older cones need to be replaced.
- Sewer:
  - Mr. Veres and Mr. Breidinger cleared the snow at the pump stations.
  - The Electrical Box replacements at Pump Station 1 and Pump Station 2 are on hold until the spring.
  - Council was notified that we were awarded the \$115,900.00 grant for the new pumps at Pump Station 1 and Pump Station 2.

**Mayor's Report:** Nothing at this time.

**President's Report:**

- President Breidinger advised that road salt is in short supply with anticipated deliveries approximately two weeks out.
- The salt spreader will need maintenance in the spring.
- A new deflector for the top of the plow was ordered, but it was not the correct one, so a different one will be ordered.
- The overhead door on the salt shed is old, rusted and not functioning. Council agreed not to replace the door at this time.

**Zoning Officer's Report:**

- 8 High Street – the new owner is working on cleaning up the property and has inquired about the needed plans, permits and inspections.
- 212 High Street – Inquiry for emergency oil tank replacement.
