Trius – The plow truck and salt spreader was taken to Trius for repair and maintenance. They have not yet provided an estimate for the work, but on a motion from Ms. Caswell, seconded by Mrs. Harstine, council unanimously approved repairs up to \$5,000.00.

Weed Control – Weeds, Inc. has provided a proposal of \$2,014.00 to chemically control vegetation along the guardrails from 100 Main Street to the Glendon Bridge as well as Berger Road (designated areas shown on provided map), and the four (4) pump stations.

- They will use an approved aquatic herbicide for the culvert on Berger Road.
- The proposal includes one (1) respray for re-emergent weeds.
- Treatment was recommended to be performed as soon as possible.

Council unanimously accepted the proposal on a motion from Mrs. Harstine, seconded by Ms. Caswell.
